Sub: Grant of Extended permission to Z.V.M Unani Medical College & Hospital, 2390-B, KB Hidayathulla Road, New Modikhana Camp, Azam Campus, Anglo Urdu School Campus, Pune-411001 (MS) (Inst. Id: UNI0297) with intake capacity of 60 seats in UG (BUMS) course and 17 seats in 04 PG courses in the subject namely (i) Moalajat-06 seats (ii) Tahafuzzi-wa-samaji Tib-06 seats (iii) Ilmul Jarahat- 03 seats and (iv) Ilmul Qabalat-wa-Amraz-e-Niswan -02 seats for the academic session 2025-26, under section 28 of NCISM Act, 2020 and relevant regulations thereunder-regarding.

Sir/Madam,

- To assess the available facilities of teaching, non-teaching, hospital staff, practical training and other infrastructure facilities at your college namely Z.V.M Unani Medical College & Hospital, 2390-B, KB Hidayathulla Road, New Modikhana Camp, Azam Campus, Anglo Urdu School Campus, Pune-411001 (MS) (Inst. Id: UNI0297) inspection was conducted on 28.05.2025 and 29.05.2025, as a part of annual visitation by the visitation team of Medical Assessment and Rating Board, NCISM to process the permission with intake capacity of 60 seats in UG (BUMS) course and 17 seats in 04 PG courses in the subject namely (i) Moalajat-06 seats (ii) Tahafuzzi-wa-samaji Tib-06 seats (iii) Ilmul Jarahat- 03 seats and (iv) Ilmul Qabalat-wa-Amraz-e-Niswan -02 seats for the academic session 2025-26 under section 28 of NCISM Act, 2020.
- The visitation report and all other related documents were assessed in terms of enforced regulations namely the Minimum Essential Standards, Assessment and Rating for Undergraduate Unani colleges and Attached Teaching Hospitals Regulations, 2023", and Minimum Standards for Postgraduate Education in Unani) Regulations, 2024, provisions under the NCISM Act, 2020 and relevant regulations thereunder. On careful examination of the assessment report following shortcomings/defects were observed:-

1. Biometric attendance

- Aadhar enabled Biometric attendance System to track attendance is available for the teaching staff but not available for non-teaching staff and Hospital Staff.
- However, on verification with AEBAS team, it came to notice that 38 faculties have been registered on AEBAS and 09 out of 38 faculties are not fulfilling the minimum AEBAS requirements. The details are as under:-

- 3) Accordingly, the assessment report has been carefully examined in terms concerned Regulation and provisions under the NCISM Act, 2020 and relevant regulations there under and as per the direction of competent authority the assessment report was placed in 139th Board Meeting of MARB-ISM held on 06.08.2025 and the Board decided to seek clarification from the college with regard to afore mentioned shortcoming/defects and the same was informed to you vide letter of even no. dated 13.08.2025. In response of the same you have submitted the clarification vide letter ref. No. ZVMUMC&H/2109/Est. dated 14.08.2025.
- 4) Further, in view of the clarification submitted by you, the assessment report along with clarification was placed in the 144th Board meeting of Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine (NCISM) held on 29.08.2025 and Board decided that the college is not fulfilling the notified & requisite criteria for issuance of permission as per the Concerned Acts and regulations but fulfilling the criteria for issuance of Extended Permission in accordance with the Board's policy letter issued on 23.01.2025. Hence, the Board decided to issue the Extended permission with intake capacity of 60 seats in UG (BUMS) course and 17 seats in 04 PG courses in the subject namely (i) Moalajat-06 seats (ii) Tahafuzzi-wa-samaji Tib-06 seats (iii) Ilmul Jarahat- 03 seats and (iv) Ilmul Qabalat-wa-Amraz-e-Niswan -02 seats for the academic session 2025-26 under section 28 of NCISM Act, 2020.

"DECISION"

- 5) Therefore, Extended Permission is hereby granted to Z.V.M Unani Medical College & Hospital, 2390-B, KB Hidayathulla Road, New Modikhana Camp, Azam Campus, Anglo Urdu School Campus, Pune-411001 (MS) (Inst. Id: UN10297) with intake capacity of 60 seats in UG (BUMS) course and 17 seats in 04 PG courses in the subject namely (i) Moalajat-06 seats (ii) Tahafuzzi-wa-samaji Tib-06 seats (iii) Ilmul Jarahat- 03 seats and (iv) Ilmul Qabalat-wa-Amraz-e-Niswan -02 seats in accordance with Regulation 16 (1) of MESAR UG (Unani) 2023 & Regulation 16 (5) of MESAR PG Unani, 2024 and as per the Policy letter dated 23.01.2025 under section 28 of NCISM Act, 2020 and subject to the condition that the following requirements shall be fulfilled:
- I. It is further informed that minimum 15% of undergraduate and 15% of Postgraduate seats of the permitted intake capacity of 60 UG (BUMS) seats and 17 seats in 04 PG courses shall be treated as all India quota. The counseling for seats under all India quota shall be conducted by respective counseling authority as designated by Central Government for A.Y. 2025-26 and counseling for the remaining 85% seats or as the case may be, shall be conducted by the concerned Counseling Authority of that State/UT. The permission of the college stands withdrawn if the college fails to comply with the aforesaid direction for all India quota or the students admitted thereunder.
- II. Determination of fee and all other charges in respect of 50% of seats in private Medical Institutions and deemed to be University should be as per the guidelines issued by NCISM vide ref no. BUSS/Fee/ASU/2022-23 dated 16.09.2022. Fees of the remaining 50% of seats are to be fixed as per the guidelines of Fee Fixation/Regulatory Committee (FRC) of respective State/UT/Deemed to be University.
- 6) Admissions made in violation of the above conditions will be treated as invalid and action will be initiated under NCISM Act & Regulations thereunder.
- 7) Further, as per Sub-section (7) of Section 29 of NCISM Act, 2020, The Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine may conduct evaluation and assessment of any University or medical institution at any time, either directly or through any other expert, having integrity and experience in medical profession, without any prior notice and assess and evaluate the performance, standards and benchmarks of such University or medical institution and if the college is found to be not maintaining the Minimum Essential standards as specified in the concerned Acts & Regulations then in accordance of Section 28 (1) (f) of NCISM Act, 2020 the issued permission of the college shall deemed to be withdrawn and denial of permission shall be issued by MARBISM for stoppage of admission for that particular academic year or the subsequent year.

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- 8) Discrepancies, if any, may be immediately brought to the notice of Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine, NCISM.
- 9) The following requirements should be fulfilled by the college as per Regulation 16(3)(b) of MESAR UG Unani, 2023 and the compliance report shall be submitted before 31st December, 2025 to be considered for the process of issuance of permission for the academic session 2026-2027:-
 - i) All the requirements under the provisions of the NCISM Act, 2020 and relevant Regulations made there under should be fulfilled.
 - ii) All the requirements of Minimum Standard of Infrastructure and teaching & training facilities as specified in NCISM (Minimum essential standards, assessment and rating for undergraduate Unani colleges and attached teaching hospitals) Regulations, 2023.
 - iii) All the requirements of Minimum Standard of Infrastructure and teaching & training facilities as specified in NCISM (Minimum essential standards, assessment and rating for Postgraduate Unani colleges and attached teaching hospitals) Regulations, 2024.
 - iv) All the requirements of the National Commission for Indian System of Medicine (Minimum Standards of Undergraduate Unani Education) Regulations-2022.
- 10) The fulfillment of the conditions given above may be made within the time period specified and compliance report should be submitted by the college within the timeline as mentioned above to the President, Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine. The Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine will verify that the conditions have been fulfilled for considering the permission for the academic session 2026-27.
